



## **A Level Core Maths**

### **Introduction to this course**

Taking Core Maths as part of your study programme will build on many familiar mathematical theories you have previously studied to help prepare learners to be confident in using maths in their careers. It is a good choice if you would like to continue your maths after GCSE and want to develop skills in context, which is the main difference between Core Maths and Maths at A Level.

### **Entry Requirements**

You will need five GCSEs at grades A\* to C, including maths at grade B or above.

### **Career prospects**
